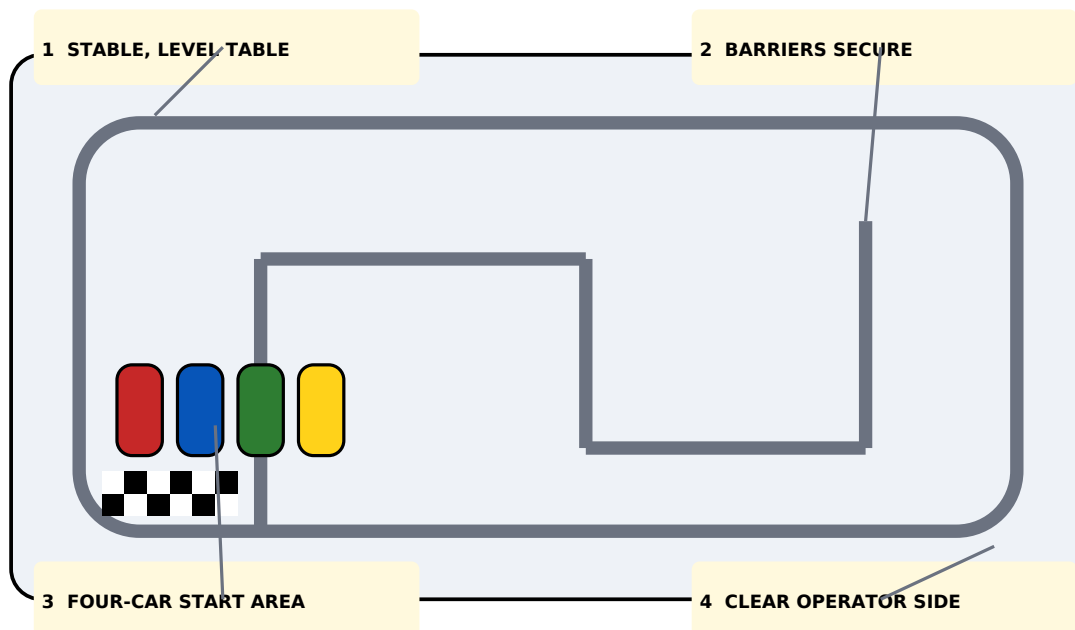




RC CARS & TRACK TABLE SAFETY USER MANUAL

1:43 gyro-assisted RC racing and tabletop track operation



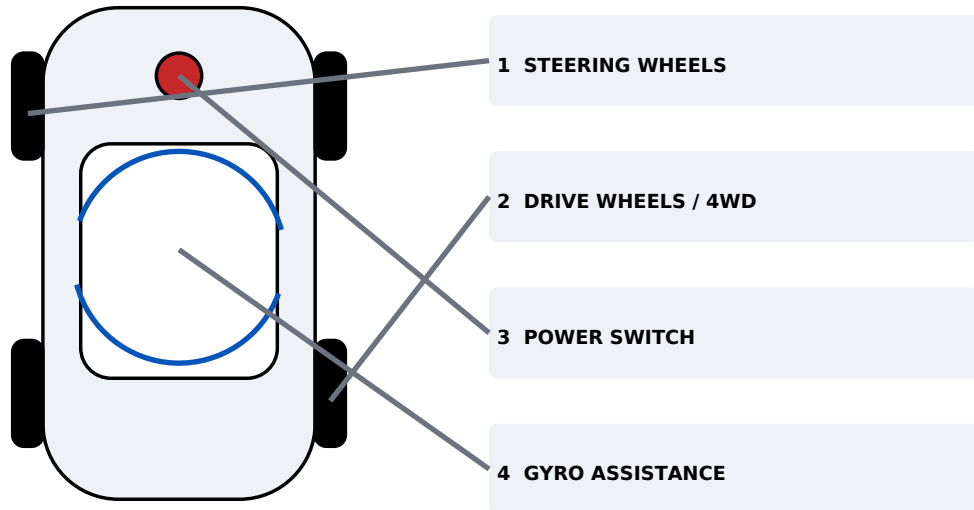
A responsible adult must supervise setup, charging and use. Keep all cars on the track table and stop play if any equipment becomes unsafe.

EQUIPMENT	INTENDED USE
1:43-scale 2.4 GHz gyro-assisted RC cars and matched controllers.	Up to four drivers racing on the Wheelie Kids tabletop circuit under active supervision.

This manual is based on the supplied Wheelie Kids track arrangement and the referenced 1:43 gyro-car product family. Controller layouts, charging leads and adjustment controls can vary; always follow the label supplied with the actual car, controller and charger.

1. KNOW THE RC CAR & GYRO ASSISTANCE

The cars are compact 1:43-scale racing/drift models using 2.4 GHz radio control. The gyro senses unwanted rotation and applies steering correction to help the car hold a more stable direction.

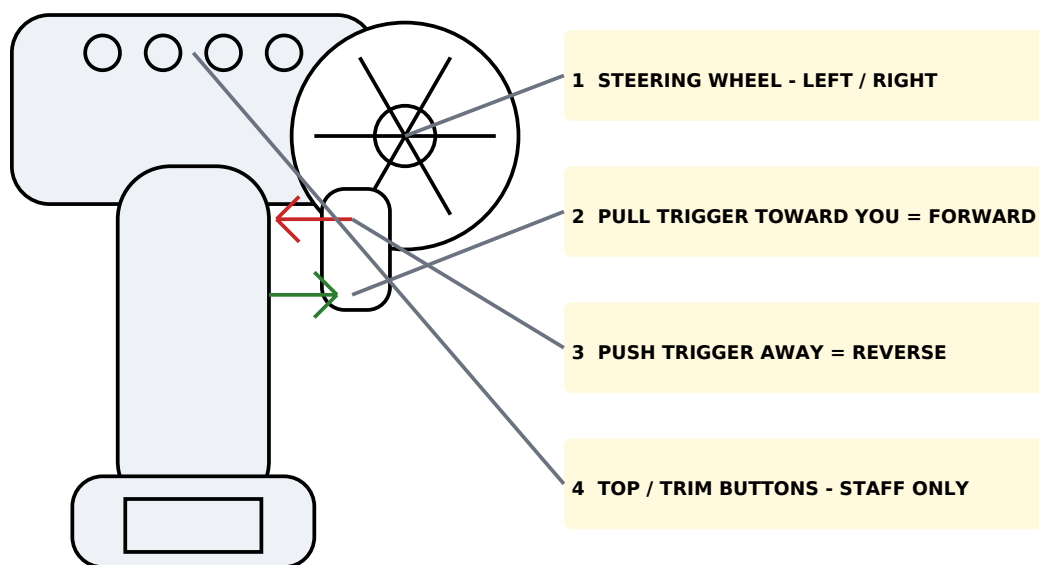


FEATURE	WHAT IT DOES	SAFETY POINT
Gyro assistance	Helps stabilise direction and makes small corrections.	It does not drive, steer or stop the car automatically.
Proportional steering/throttle where fitted	Control response changes with controller input.	Begin gently; sudden full input can cause spins or impacts.
Four-wheel drive	Provides drive through all four wheels.	Keep fingers, hair and loose items away from turning wheels.
2.4 GHz radio	Allows multiple matched cars to operate together.	Confirm each controller is paired to the intended car before racing.

GYRO = STABILITY ASSISTANCE ONLY. The driver must still steer, control speed and stop.

2. CONTROLLER, PAIRING & BASIC DRIVING

Customers use the side steering wheel and throttle trigger only. Top and trim buttons are reserved for staff setup and adjustment; their exact function is not required for normal customer operation.



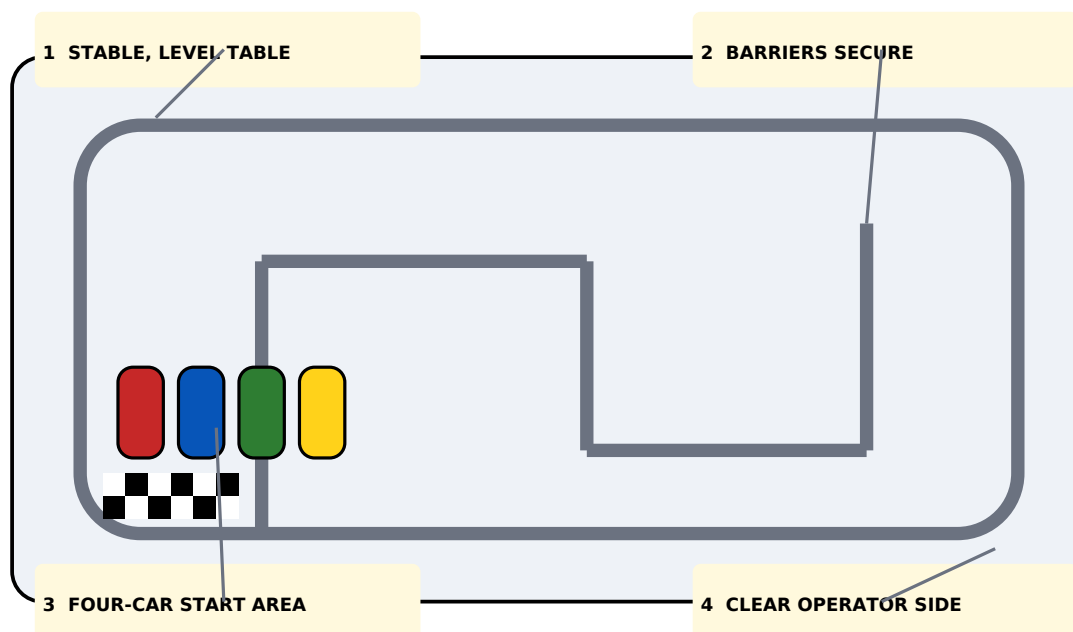
Customers use the wheel and trigger only.

STEP	ACTION
1 - Allocate	Give each driver one car and its matched controller. Keep the same pairing for the session.
2 - Start safely	Place the car on the start area before powering or pairing it. Leave the trigger centred.
3 - Pair	Switch on in the order specified for the actual set. Confirm only the intended car responds.
4 - Test	Turn the wheel left/right. Pull the trigger gently toward the handle for forward; push it away for reverse.
5 - Drive	Use small, smooth wheel and trigger movements. Return the trigger to neutral before changing direction.
6 - Stop	Release the trigger to neutral, switch the car off, then switch the controller off as directed.

CUSTOMER CONTROLS: steering wheel + trigger only. Staff manage top/trim adjustments.

3. TRACK TABLE SETUP

The Wheelie Kids track is approximately 3 m x 2 m and is designed for four racers. Set it up only where the complete table is stable, level and protected from people walking into it.



CHECK	PASS STANDARD
Floor and access	Level, dry and clear; provide safe access around the operating side without blocking exits.
Table structure	All legs, frames, joins and braces locked; no rocking, bending, sharp edges or missing fixings.
Track surface	Flat, clean and dry with no lifted edges, loose objects or damaged sections.
Barriers	Secure and continuous so cars cannot readily leave the tabletop.
Start area	Cars aligned with space between them; controllers assigned before activation.
Exclusion zone	Children must not climb, sit, lean heavily, crawl under or pull on the table or track.
Capacity	Maximum four active drivers unless Wheelie Kids has specifically approved another arrangement.

STOP USE if the table moves, tilts, separates or cannot support the track securely.

4. PRE-USE INSPECTION & SESSION START

Any failed check means the affected car, controller, charger or table is OUT OF SERVICE.

CHECK	PASS STANDARD	✓
Cars	Bodies secure; wheels rotate freely; no cracks, loose parts, exposed wiring, swelling, heat or damage.	
Controllers	Battery covers secure; controls centre/return correctly; no loose or damaged parts.	
Pairing	Every controller operates only its assigned car.	
Gyro/trim	Car tracks predictably at low speed; adjustment is made only by a trained supervisor.	
Track/table	Stable, level, complete and clear; barriers secure.	
Charging area	Adult-controlled, dry, ventilated, non-combustible surface away from play.	
Drivers	Briefed on gentle controls, staying in lane, no grabbing cars and immediate stop signal.	

Participant briefing

- Keep the car on the tabletop track and use smooth controller movements.
- Do not touch a moving car, wheels or another driver's controller.
- Stop immediately when instructed and place the controller down safely.
- Tell the supervisor if the car becomes hot, smells unusual, stops responding or leaves the track.

5. SAFE RACING & SUPERVISION

DRIVER RULE	SUPERVISOR CONTROL
One assigned car and controller at a time.	Confirm pairings and maintain line-of-sight supervision.
Use gentle throttle and steering inputs.	Reduce speed or pause racing when control is poor.
Keep hands off the track while cars are moving.	Stop all cars before retrieving, resetting or repairing one.
No throwing cars, controllers or track pieces.	Remove damaged equipment immediately.
Do not deliberately ram, block or push cars off the track.	Use fair race rules and safe spacing.
Keep drinks, food and liquids away.	Maintain a dry equipment and charging area.

Car leaves the track or becomes unresponsive

- Stop every active driver before anyone reaches onto or around the table.
- Switch off the affected car before inspection.
- Check wheels for trapped debris and inspect the body, battery area and controls.
- Re-pair only in a controlled area. If operation remains erratic, tag the car out of service.

Never retrieve a car while other cars are moving.

6. CHARGING, BATTERIES & STORAGE

The cars recharge directly through their USB-C connection using the leads provided with the booking. Controllers use supplied rechargeable AA or AAA batteries with a compatible charger. Confirm the actual battery size and polarity marked in each controller before fitting or charging.

RULE	REQUIREMENT
Adult only	Charging, battery access and lead connection are adult tasks.
RC cars	Recharge directly through the car USB-C connection using the USB-C charging leads provided with the booking.
Controllers	Use the supplied rechargeable AA or AAA batteries and the provided compatible battery charger. Confirm battery size and polarity before fitting.
Inspect first	Do not charge damaged, swollen, wet, leaking, unusually hot or punctured batteries/cars.
Correct equipment	Use only the provided matching USB-C leads and battery charger. Never force a connector or mix unsuitable batteries.
Safe location	Charge on a dry, stable, non-combustible surface with ventilation and direct adult monitoring.
No play during charging	Keep cars, rechargeable cells and leads away from children and do not operate while connected to a charger.
After charging	Disconnect USB-C by the plug housing, allow equipment to cool and store leads without tight bends.
Rotation	Use the numbered/car-ID rotation system so charged and resting cars are clearly separated.

STOP immediately for smoke, swelling, hissing, sparks, leakage, strong odour or excessive heat. Isolate the area and follow the site emergency procedure.

Storage

- Switch off cars and controllers.
- Clean with a soft dry or lightly damp cloth; do not immerse or spray electrical components.
- Store cars, controllers and charging leads in labelled compartments in a cool, dry, secure indoor area.
- Store track pieces flat or supported so barriers and the tabletop surface cannot deform.
